1. M/S.FERMENTA BIOTECH LTD.:

LOA No. Dahej SEZ/II/16/2009-10 dated 11.03.2010 was issued to M/s. Fermenta Biotech Ltd. The unit vide letter No. Dahej/LOA/Amemd/2011-12 dated 05.12.2011 requested for expansion of production capacity of existing products and inclusion of following new product in their authorized operations.

Further, M/s. Fermenta Biotech Ltd. requested for expansion in the existing facilities due to the automation in the manufacturing process equipments in the installed capacity.

They further submitted the following points:

- The incremental production of Vitamin D3 Resin of 4 tons would be used in the products extension of Vitamin D3 Resin in the form of "Vitamin D3 500iu Feedgrade" (Formulation).
- They do not have a formulation facility at Dahej. So they would be sending the Vitamin D3 Resin in diluted form to the formulator outside the Dahej SEZ but after complying with required procedure of the Customs Authorities. In other words, they would be outsourcing the manufacturing of Vitamin D3 500iu Feedgrade by sending the Vitamin D3 Resing from Dahej SEZ.
- Due to extension of Vitamin D3 Resin, NFE earnings would be increased by ₹ 3929 lac.

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- The new product Vitamin D3 500iu Feed Grade would be processed by third party manufacturer located outside the SEZ and hence
 - No pollution issue as no process will be carried out in the unit in SEZ except repacking, labeling and analysis.
 - o The requirement of labour will be bare minimum to the extent of 2-3 additional persons basically to repack the goods.
 - No additional capital investment as the product will be manufactured will be outsourced and the incremental Vitamin D3 Resin required for the same will be produced with the existing manufacturing set up.
 - Raw materials declared earlier for the product Vitamin D3 & its allied products are the same required for the basic raw material of the new product since it belongs to the same family of products.

2. M/S.ISGEC HEAVY ENGINEERING LTD. (PREVIOUSLY KNOWN AS M/S.THE SARASWATI INDUSTRIAL SYNDICATE LTD.):

(i) M/s. ISGEC Heavy Engineering Ltd.(Previously known as M/s.The Saraswati Industrial Syndicate Ltd.) vide letter No.SIS/JW-DTS/2011-2012 dated 11.10.2011 requested for permission for doing job work in SEZ for Domestic Tariff Area units.

M/s. ISGEC submitted that they are a heavy engineering equipment manufacturing unit and so they have to fulfill many formalities/permissions from various departments/offices. Further they would like to take ISO-9001 certification. The above processes take a considerable amount of time, during which their facilities in the unit will remain idle.

M/s. ISGEC further submitted that they have number of orders for manufacture of heavy engineering equipment on job work basis for DTA units, but none of these orders are intended for exports. Therefore, they requested to permit them to undertake job work of DTA units in their SEZ plant and after completion of the job work, return the resultant product back to such DTA units for being further worked upon and/or for clearance for home consumption.

As per the Rule 43 of SEZ Rules, 2006, a unit may undertake sub-contracting on behalf of DTA exporter subject to the condition that finished goods may be exported but for the job working from the DTA units is not permitted.

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(ii) M/s. ISGEC vide letter No.IHEL/DSB/LOP/2011-12 dated 15.12.2011 submitted that at the time of filing Form-F, they omitted the name and description of Parts/Byproducts. Now, they would like the following products (parts of main products) and byproducts to be included in their authorized operations:

M/s.ISGEC further submitted vide letter dated 26.12.2011 that, there would be no change in investments, employment or Capital Goods/infrastructure. NFE would also remain unchanged as the same be cleared as part of the final products.

3. M/S.ONGC PETRO ADDITIONS LTD.:

M/s.ONGC Petro Additions Ltd. vide letter No.OPaL/BDA/EN/COR/106/10-11 dated 05.10.2011 requested for approval for proposed Captive Power Plant in Dahej SEZ. They submitted that as per original project configuration, power plant was not included but as petrochemical plant is extremely sensitive to power outages and therefore Captive Power Plant(CPP) is considered as a mandatory process requirement. It was also recommended by their Project management consultant, M/s.Engineers India Ltd.(EIL).

M/s.OPAL envisioned to setup a combined cycle CPP (Steam & Power Generation System package) comprising of 2 UBs (220TPH each), 2 STGs (30 MW each), 4 GTGs (33.75 MW each), 4 HRSGs (110 TPH each) and associated BOP to meet the requirement of about 880 TPH process steam and 195 MW power for the petrochemical complex.

DC office vide letter dated 02.12.2011 requested to M/s.OPAL to submit the detailed project report along with effect on NFE earning calculations regarding the proposed CPP. In reply M/s.OPAL submitted Pre-feasibility study report on CPP dated 12.12.2011 submitted to DC office.

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As per the Power Guidelines issued from F.No. P.6/3/2006-SEZ.1 dated 27.02.2009 by the MoCI, a unit can be set up within the SEZ to generate power as a product or have a captive power plant and will be located in the processing area
